## **CURRICULUM 2020**

The curriculum fulfils the Act (559/1994 and 1200/2007), Decree (564/1994) and EU directives (updated 2013/55/EU) on health care professionals as well as nationally agreed competence requirements of registered nurse and public health nurse education (2019). The public health nurse programme (240 ECTS) includes the education of a registered nurse.

#### PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE 240 ECTS BASIC STUDIES 10 ECTS:

Nursing studies comprise of seven thematic sections divided into study modules. The thematic sections are:

- The basis of professional encounters and the service system 29 ECTS
- Inclusion and guidance 32 ECTS
- Clinic nursing 29 ECTS
- Variety of life paths and health promotion 62 ECTS
- Applied and developing expertise 30 ECTS
- Participatory research and advocacy 30 ECTS
- The ethical nature of nursing and future-proof expertise 28 ECTS

The studies follow the Community-Based Participatory Research model (CBPR) where learning and assignments can be used to benefit the development needs in the working life.
